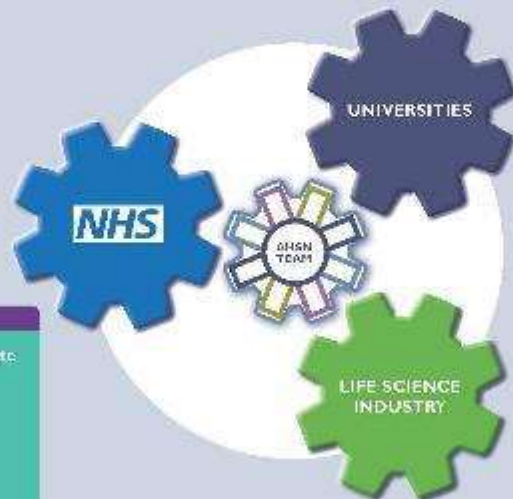
BACKGROUND

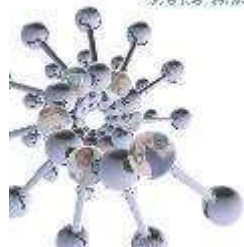
Benefits of collaboration across the whole system:

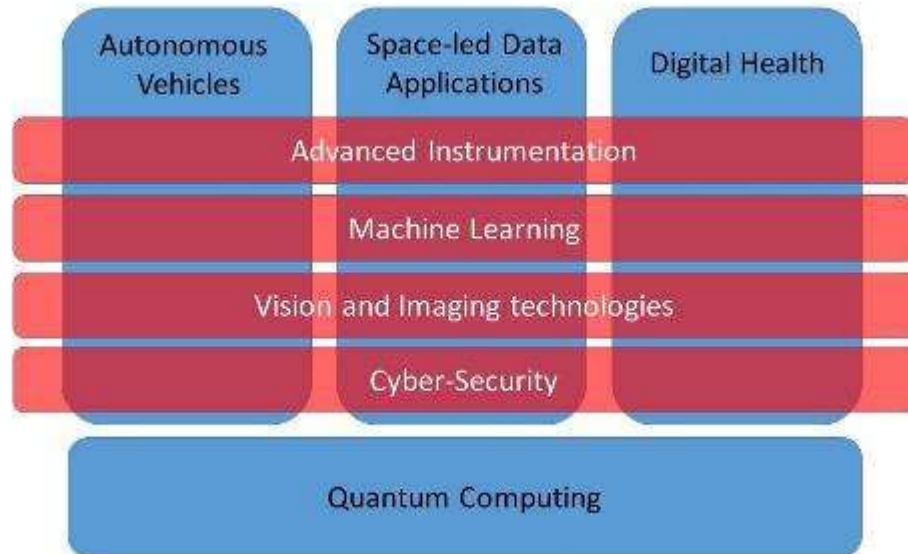

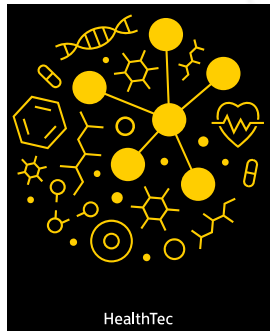

What do hospitals and space have in common?

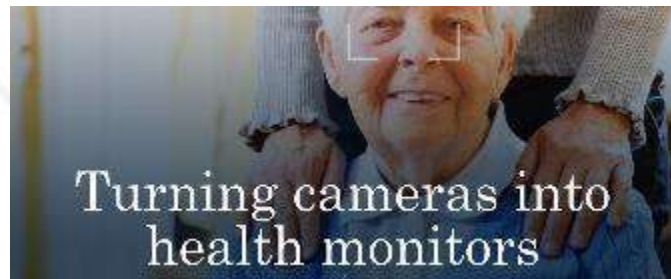
- Extreme environments.....
